

Save Your Community's Citrus From a Deadly Tree Disease

Huanglongbing, a devastating plant disease also known as citrus greening disease or yellow dragon disease, has been found nearby.

All citrus varieties – including mandarin, orange, tangerine, kumquat, pomelo and lemon trees – are at risk. Infected citrus trees will die and need to be removed from yards to protect other nearby trees.

Cooperate

Agriculture crews are working in the area to find and stop the disease. Please allow them to access your property.

Don't Move Citrus

Do not transport citrus fruit, plant clippings or trees because you could spread the disease. Never bring citrus here from other countries.

Remove Your Tree

If you do not care for your citrus tree, proactively remove it. Less trees mean fewer opportunities for the disease to spread.
